Behind the pseudonym Natsa Muse like a flight of colours and inspiration, Nathalie Michiels is a painter with positive ideas.

Born into an artistic family, great-granddaughter of the sculptor Alfred Courtens and a trained psychologist and life coach, Nathalie creates decorative paintings with the desire to bring joy and light into the home.

Composed of gourmet textures, in a nod to the recreational pleasures that boost morale and reflect the small pleasures of everyday life, two collections vie with each other in cheerful tones: Fleurs intemporelles and Good vibes.

The first showcases the beauty of roses in relief, bringing the wall to life. 'I wanted to create a sensation of volume and depth using different materials to encourage the viewer to move around the canvas to open up their vision and understand that it will depend on their angle of view. This is in line with my philosophy of existence and the tools available to us in new psychology'. More boldly coloured, and still with the desire to inject a happy vibrancy into the atmosphere, the second painting reveals infinite lines in very vivid shades.

The edges of the painting are worked over to create an effect of surprise and wonder. 'Putting colour at home is good for the soul' says Nathalie, who has exhibited several times, notably at the Sablon, and has already been approached by galleries in Paris, Barcelona and Marbella... An artist to watch out for in her future projects.
