I have a background in political science and have been working for nearly five years at the European Commission, where I have been passionately contributing to the ambitious EU peace project. At the same time, during my stay in Brussels, I have also been nurturing my longstanding passion for the arts and photography.

I have been at a crossroads and have taken a decisive step. In the coming months, I will be transitioning fully into the study of documentary photography with the ambition of giving voice to the most vulnerable and raising awareness of the social injustices of our times.

Exhibiting my work at nhow Brussels Bloom marks an important step in this new journey: an opportunity to share my vision, connect with audiences, and open the door to collaborations worldwide where I can bring my perspective, empathy and sociopolitical understanding.
