At 21 years old, alongside his marketing studies, the Liège-based artist Steven Bruhl-Zutterman gives urban landscapes a new and unexpected life.

Armed with acrylic paint markers, he draws inspiration from architectural deconstructivism and Pierre Delavie's trompe-l'œil to create an anti-physical vision of the city.

Under his gaze, familiar buildings start to melt, ripple, or stretch, as if the architecture itself were breathing and transforming. His skies, for their part, borrow their intensity and movement from Van Gogh, adding a vibrant and poetic touch to his compositions.

This year, Steven dedicated a series of 16 paintings to Brussels, offering the capital a vision that is both surprising and deeply personal.
